The **Spanish Association of Breeders of the Malague- ña Goat (CABRAMA)**, founded in 1986 and based in Casabermeja, is an entity committed to the development of the
rural areas of our province that focuses its activities around
the figure of the Malagueña Goat and their products.

The province of Málaga is the territory with the highest concentration of goats in Europe and the main producer of goat's milk in Spain. Part of our landscape has been modeled by goat activity and their shepherds, and there is also an interesting architectural, cultural and food patrimony linked to livestock activity. We have a great breed; the Malagueña Goat, which despite everything remains a great unknown to our citizens.

From CABRAMA we have raised a new challenge, to approach the citizens through innovative initiatives in the field of **training**, **dissemination and touristic diversification of livestock farming**.

For this we have developed a **wide range of activities**, aimed at adults and children, and we also have the **Malagueña Goat House**, a space to develop all our activities installed in the former algalcilería de Casabermeja. It includes a small **museum**, **screening room**, **workshops and tastings and a space for the exhibition of our products**.
